Volunteers are needed, particularly with the Silent Auction. If you can help, please call Gloria at 905-935-1168

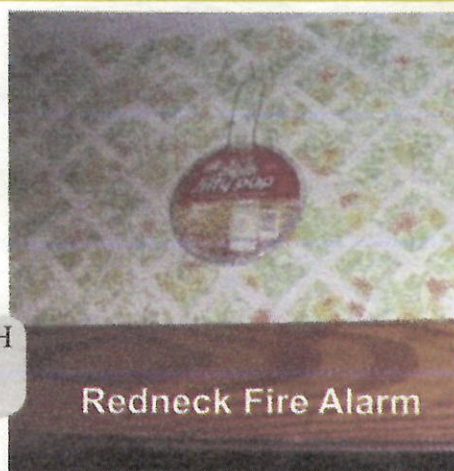
